

    - We read not to master but to be mastered by.
    - We come to the Word of God not to question His authority but to humble ourselves in light of its authority.
    - 3. One Word of Revelation is worth more than ten thousand pages of information.
    - 4. We learn to tolerate and even embrace ambiguity.
    - 5. We seek not the control of certainty but the quest for clarity.
    - 6. Our conclusions must be solid and yet tentative. We see dimly in a glass.
    - 7. We come to apply the whole of ourselves to the text and the whole of the text to ourselves. (Bengel's Dictum)
    - 8. "I stake everything on the promise of the Word of God." (Sower's Creed)
    - 9. "I have thought I am creature of a day, passing through life as an arrow through the air. I am a spirit come from God and returning to God; just hovering over the great gulf, till a few moments hence I am no more seen. I drop into an unchangeable eternity! I want to know one thing, the way to heaven—how to land safe on that happy shore. God himself has condescended to teach the way: for this very end he came from heaven. He hath written it down in a book. O give me that book! At any price give me the Book of God! I have it. Here is knowledge enough for me. Let me be homo unius libri [a man of one book]." —John Wesley
