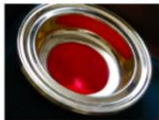

Tuesday, June 20th: food distribution day

9am: unload food bank truck and store food; **10am to noon:** sort produce; finish boxes; **11:30am to noon:** homebound teams pick up boxes in the church library; **Noon to 1:45pm:** lunch on your own; **2pm:** devotions; **2:30 to 3pm:** set up tables, boxes and meat carts; **3pm to 5:30pm:** food distribution
